HSC update

Year 12 students are in the final weeks of school prior to undertaking the HSC examinations in November. Term 4 Organisation

Science News

In Term 3, Weeks 6, 7, 8 and 9 were challenging for all Science students as they were learning from home. Their teachers tried very hard to provide online lessons that were as engaging as possible by sourcing relevant videos, games, interactive learning activities and by creating online worksheets to complement these. Most students did a brilliant job of accessing Google Classroom and following their teacher's instructions to complete tasks so that their learning was not interrupted during this time. Students who made a particularly terrific effort were rewarded with a certificate and a chocolate!





Teachers kept a close eye on student progress, graded submitted work, provided frequent feedback and chatted to students and parents via Zoom and phone calls in order to provide the best possible education for the students in their care. Additionally, teachers created hard copy versions that were closely aligned to the online work so that students with limited internet access did not miss out on high quality learning opportunities. It was great to get back to school in Week 10 and all Science lessons were filled with practical activities and hands-on experiments so that students could consolidate what they had learned at home while enjoying working with their friends.

Now that we are back at school, all Year 7-10 Science classes are busily working towards their Yearly examination in Weeks 4 and 5. Year 7 are learning about the wonders of the universe, Year 8 are about to start expanding their knowledge of the environment, Year 9 is studying a topic on waves, and Year 10 are diving into studying evolution. Shortly students will receive a booklet to help them revise at home for their exam and they are encouraged to start spending about 15 minutes each night going over everything they have learned in Science this year. Suggested home study ideas are: reading through their Science book, making a summary for each topic, re-doing topic tests, and quizzing themselves using the Learning Intentions checklists given at the start of each topic. Past topic tests, Learning Intentions Checklists and revision booklets will be posted in Go ogle Classroom just in case students misplace their paper copies.



Year 12 students are to be commended for making it to the end of their Science courses! As they move towards the HSC examinations they still have plenty of opportunities to work with their teachers to achieve the best possible results. Revising course work and completing as many past papers as possible is a recipe for success. We wish every student all the best in the exams and beyond.
